Don't let your smart phone cause you to make a dumb decision

Workers

- Keep your phone in your pocket when you're in the yard, terminal or loading dock.
- And of course, don't text or talk while driving.

Employers

- Designate cellphone use areas and cellphone-free zones on your property.
- Train drivers to stay in their cab or other safe area and to use designated walking paths during loading and unloading.

Bonus safety tip for forklift drivers

- Always drive with load lowered and in reverse if the load will impede visibility.
